About the Pre-sessional English language course

Pre – sessional English language course is designed to prepare international students, whose first language is not English for studying at postgraduate levels with the main objective and focus on reaching the Academic English language skills which are required.





Entry requirements

- Minimum age 18 years
- ➤ A fully completed first degree-level programme (Bachelor degree certificate is required)
- Students must also meet the English language entry requirements an IELTS 4.5 or above (or equivalent SEPT or HEPT is required for students who do not hold a degree-level qualification, which was wholly taught & examined in English language).

BCC offers a pre-sessional course in 3 (three) possible options, depending on student's entry English language ability. BCC offers the duration of Pre-sessional English course in 6, 12 and 24 weeks.

Course structure

- A combination of teaching hours (face to face on BCC campus or live online sessions with the teacher)
- > Tutorials (students will have an opportunity ask teacher questions and discuss the unit)
- Independent study (in each module sections, which will be allocated time to complete tasks linked to the unit topics and practical tasks, including the assessment research)

NOTE: the length of the pre-sessional English course as above covers only 4 core units, and doesn't include the elective units. The length of additional elective units will have additional TQT 200 hours for each individual unit, worth 20 credits. TQT includes the Guided learning hours (80 Guided learning hours per each elective unit) & independent study & laboratory work. If the full course is completed, TQT 1200 hours & achievement of 120 credits is gained.

Course Overview

The Pre-sessional English Language programme is designed to prepare international students, whose first language is not English for studying at postgraduate levels with the main objective and focus on reaching Academic English language skills which are required.

Entry Requirements A fully completed first degree - level programme (Bachelor degree) An overall IELTS score of 4.5 or above or equivalent

Duration

The length of Pre-sessional English language course depends on entry language requirements by UK universities (usually IELTS 6.0 or 6.5) and student's entry language ability to 6, 12 and 24 weeks of studying.

Delivery methods

Live face-to-face online or on-campus teaching sessions in a small study group (max. 8 students) Tutorials and regular constructive feedback from lecturers Independent quided self-study work enabling student's ability for independent study, critical thinking, presentations and research.
